## TEACHING EXPERIENCE (FAIRFIELD UNIVERSITY):

**Spring 2011: Mentored a student doing an independent project** consisting of a lighting design for Theatre Fairfield's production of *Dead Man's Cell Phone*. Developed syllabus for this one semester course. Met with student twice per week to develop design ideas, research feasibility of those ideas, lay out the light plot, draft it, and generate paperwork. Supervised while he focused the show and wrote the cues.

**Spring 2007: Mentored student lighting designer** for Theatre Fairfield's *Festival*—an evening of student written plays. Guided this Economics major with *no* design training or experience through the process of developing ideas, laying out the plot, generating paperwork, focusing the show and writing the cues.

**Fall 2014: Supplemental teaching** in conjunction with my lighting design for *Dancing at Lughnasa* at Theatre Fairfield. Provided extra learning opportunities for undergraduates as we mounted this show without our regular technical director. Attended hang to support jobbed-in M.E. by helping train students in reading light plot and hanging lights. Made guest appearances in Prof. Lynne Porter's lighting class to discuss the light plot. Met with lighting students after the show had opened to allow them to write some cues using the show plot.

**Spring 2005: Mentored student assistant** for *Picasso at the Lapin Agile* at Theatre Fairfield. The student shadowed me through the process, drafted the plot, and wrote the cues in my absence. I also provided a critique of the cues he wrote.

**Spring 1999-Spring 2018: Guest artist engagements** on over 2 dozen shows at Theatre Fairfield. This brings me into constant contact with students whom I teach and mentor informally, supporting the department faculty by offering comments and feedback to students in all areas about professional practice and professional conduct.

**Spring 2019-present: Adjunct appointment** for the design of shows produced by Theatre Fairfield. Training of students to operate the light board and support for student stage managers and student company members answering questions and familiarizing them with professional practice. These appointments combined with guest artist engagements have brought the total number of shows lit at Theatre Fairfield to over 3 dozen.

**Spring 2023: Guest appearance** in introductory theatre course while students worked with lights from my plot for *Eurydice*, experimenting with wide-ranging looks.

**Fall 2022: Guest appearance** in undergraduate lighting design class presenting a lecture to students about what lighting designers do and demonstrating my lighting for *Tiny Beautiful Things*.

**Fall 2010: Multiple guest appearances in TA300** (Special topics—stage lighting) to aid in evaluating student lab exercises.

**Spring 2010:** Presented **guest lecture** about my lighting design for *Romeo & Juliet* to students in TA210 (Theatre in Production.) This course served as a companion course for the production company of *The R & J Project*--a production of *Romeo & Juliet* directed by guest artist Barbra Berlovitz with costumes designed by her sister, Sonya Berlovitz.

**Fall 2007:** Presented **guest lecture** about qualities of light and the lighting design process in the introductory stage design course.

## ADDITIONAL TEACHING EXPERIENCE:

**Spring 2025:** Trinity College, THDN 213; Theatrical Lighting Design

**Spring 2018: Wesleyan University--private tutor for undergraduate** acting major needing extra help to pass introductory lighting course. Guided student through learning to draw photometric worksheets for initial and midterm assignments.

**1993-present: Have taught many dozens of college and high school students** to run a light board, focus lights and do lighting notes in conjunction with designing over 160 shows for Penobscot Theatre Company, Horse Cave Theatre, Theatre Fairfield, Bard Theatre of Drama and Dance and Theater at Monmouth.

**Spring 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989: Teaching Fellow, Harvard University:** Taught two sections of roughly 15 students each semester in Biology 25 (Neurobiology.) Though there were some course-wide problem sets and exams, I had primary responsibility for the content of my sections. Developed exercises to deepen student understanding of course material. Participated in writing exam questions and grading exams. Met with individual students during office hours for one on one tutoring. Attended all lectures delivered by head professor.
